## About Cranberry Lake

Cranberry Lake was originally formed in 1830 to serve as a reservoir for the Morris Canal. In the 1920's, the Cranberry Lake Development Company built vacation homes at Cranberry Lake. In response to the recreational needs of the residents of these vacation homes, the Cranberry Lake Community Club (CLCC) was established in 1924. Today, Cranberry Lake boasts year-round homes as well as numerous vacation homes.

The CLCC maintains a quality program of activities and services at reasonable rates to its members. In addition to scheduled events and organized programs, the following CLCC facilities & services are covered by your dues (except where noted) and are available to you:
